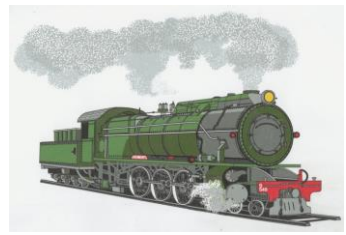

This was the culmination of four years of fund raising and negotiations. The building is in exactly the same spot as the original station. The exterior is as close as possible to the original station, right down to the seasoned Jarrah weatherboards and sash windows.



The dimensions are identical to the original. What is most amazing is that, other than the erection of the steel frame, the electrics and the plumbing, the building was completed by volunteers. It was decided to use a steel frame on this project due to the white ant problem that existed in the whole area.

The interior of the station is designed to be a modern clean open setup with toilet facilities including disability toilets.

This is a display of our coal figurines imported from the UK. They are made from deep mine coal and hand carved by ex-miners, therefore ensuring the continuation of their connection with the coal industry that has been part of their heritage for generations.



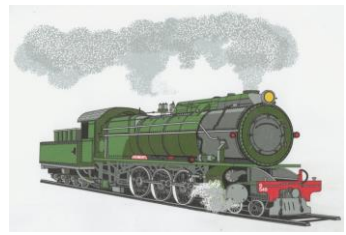
The above mural was painted by four primary school students and must be seen to be appreciated

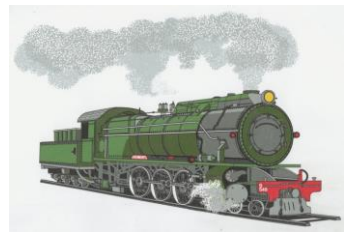
You can park in the lay-by at the station entrance.
